## Rules and Regulations

- Horses to be flu vaccinated and be **within the 12 month booster.**
- The Judges decision is final.
- Hard Hats must be worn at all times when mounted conforming to PAS 015 or BSEN1384 Standard.
- All classes are run under British Dressage Rules. Bridle numbers OR saddle pad numbers must be worn. **ONE ON EACH SIDE**
- No Horse/Pony under four years old.
- Stallions by appointment.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- No Galloping or Lunging allowed on the showground.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any class and reserve the right to alter the schedule and to close or cancel classes.
- Entries withdrawn AFTER closing date will be charged for and may not be carried forward.
- Body protector are also strongly recommended for all show jumping events. A BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label or 2018 Blue label must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing

## Health and Safety

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
