Please note the following restrictions :

- Any non riders/visitors will be charged for food and refreshments £5/day.
- There will be a shared tack room available. Riders are expected to keep their tack rooms tidy and equipment such as mucking out equipment needs to be brought.
- Horses will be allocated stables and they must stick to these stables.
- Horses will not be allowed to be tied up outside the stables for ANY reason. All mucking out and tacking up must be done in the stables.
- A £25 refundable cash deposit is required for stables. This will be returned on departure providing your stable is clean and empty. This is a requirement of Lincomb Equestrian.
- **NO** dogs will be allowed on site
- Catering facilities are available including fridge, microwave, kettle, toaster. There will be **NO** cups/glasses/mugs so please bring your own.



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- Current and correct hat and body protector standards must be adhered to at all times. Hats must worn at all times whilst mounted. Body protectors are compulsory on the cross country course.
- Lincomb Equestrian rules and guidelines must be followed at all times.
