





Bewdley Bridle Club Show Jumping Competition

- Riders are invited to dress in Team GB colours !!
- Standard BSJA rules apply
- Rosettes to 6th place
- If entries warrant, each class can be split into Junior and Senior sections
- All rounds will be timed, including the jump off
- Pairs the first competitor will jump a course, pass a baton to the second competitor who will jump the same course. The fastest pair with the fewest points will win
- **Puissance** all competitors will jump the same fences a warm up fence, a spread, and upright and then a single high fence. When all who have entered have jumped round the course, those that have gone clear go forward to the next round, where the fences are raised. This continues until there is a single horse / rider left and they will be pronounced the winners.
- **Team Competition** 4 horse / rider combinations enter as a team, best 3 scores to count. Any height can be entered but the team must declare it's members and their class on the entry form. All members will automatically enter the individual competition and total team scores will be taken from the best of 3 individual scores 10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd, 8 points for 3rd, 7 points for 4th, 6 points for 5th, 5 points for 6th, 4 points for 7th, 3 points for 8th, 2 points for 9th and 1 point for 10th. The team with the highest combined 3 scores wins

- Stallions must display a stallion disc at all times
- ➤ Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age to compete
- A child protection trained member of the organising committee is available all day contact the secretary if needed
- > Horses must not be unattended tied to the outside of vehicles.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and all fouling must be removed
- > Directions of any steward or representative of BBC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and / or being asked to leave a class / the show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- The judge's decision and that of the BBC Officials is final.
- > The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any class, and reserve the right to alter the schedule and to close or cancel classes.
- > Entries withdrawn AFTER closing date will be charged for and may not be carried forward.
- ➤ Horses must be up to date with their annual vaccinations
